Ghosed to 30%

SAVE A COPY

- Work from a copy, not the original; go to **File > Save as...**
- Add the word **Ghosed** or some other descriptive term to the end of the file name.
 - For example: 12345 P26 Background Ghosed.
- Click **Save**.


TO GHOST A PHOTO

- Open the **Levels** dialog box, **Image>Adjust>Levels** or **Command/Ctrl + L**.
- Drag the bottom left **Output Levels** slider to the right until the photo is as light as is needed.

Hint: There are 256 levels of gray; 10% of 256 is 25.6.

GHOST A PHOTO TO 30%


- Multiply 25.6 by 3
- Subtract the result, 76.8, from 256
- The answer is 179.2
- Move the slider to 179 or 180






GHOSTING A PHOTO BY 30%

- Multiply 25.6 by 3
- Subtract the result, 76.8 from 256
- The answer is 76.2
- Move the slider to about 76



GHOST PART OF A PHOTO

- Use the Marquee tool to select an area of a photo 
- Ghost the marqued area following the intructions above
