


WARP TEXT




CREATE A NEW FILE

- Go to the **File** menu and select **New**.
- The file dimensions should be the same size as the space the graphic needs to fill on the page.
- The resolution should be high enough (minimum 300 dpi) so the type will not have jagged edges.
- Use the correct mode, **grayscale** for black and white pages or **RGB** for color pages.



TYPE TOOL

- Select the **Type** tool and click on the screen.
- In the **Type Options** palette, at the top of the screen, choose a font from the pop-up menu and select a point size.



CREATE THE TEXT

- Type the text
- Click on the check mark at the right end of the **Type Options** palette to **Commit** the changes to the text layer.
- The type may have to be repositioned with the **Move** tool (V).
- Use the arrow keys or click and drag the text to reposition.



WARP TEXT

- Go to the **Layer** menu, select **Type**, then **Warp Text**...
- Choose a **Style** from the pop-up menu and watch the text change.
- The text may have to be repositioned with the **Move** tool (V).
- Play with the different options to customize.



Examples:

Fisheye **EXCELLENT**

Flag **EXCELLENT**

Bulge **EXCELLENT**

Rise **EXCELLENT**



SAVE

- If the canvas is much bigger than the text, go to **Image > Trim**, choose a **Based on point** and click **OK**.
- Save the file as a grayscale TIFF or high-res JPEG for black and white pages or as a RGB TIFF or high-res for color pages.
