BOOK SALES VIA EMAIL

Don't give up on book sales during COVID-19 closures. If you don't believe us, just listen to veteran adviser, Mitch Ziegler from Redondo Union HS in California: In the past, we always sold 150-200 books after the yearbook arrived. Since we do not know when or how yearbook distribution will occur, I was able to send out an email to all parents and students letting them know we were finalizing a date for yearbook purchases given there would be no set way for people to purchase a book after delivery. We have sold 171 yearbooks since the email went out.
