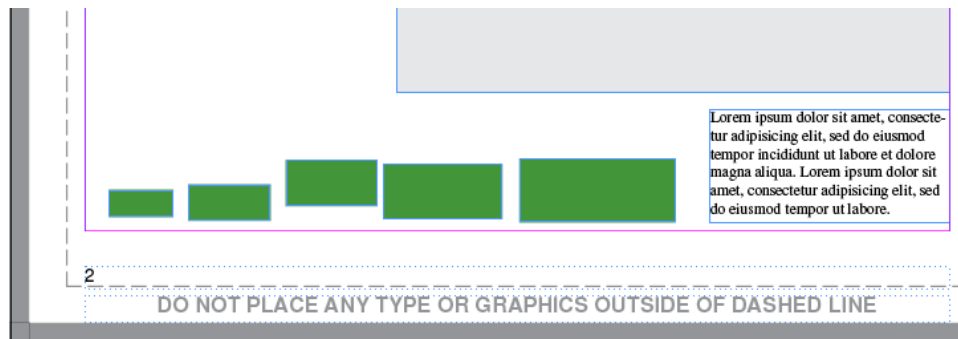




ALIGN ELEMENTS WITH ADOBE® INDESIGN®



Elements on a page can be easily aligned with the Control palette or the Align panel in Adobe InDesign.



- Click on the **Zoom** tool  to zoom in on the elements you want to align.
 - Click and drag to zoom in.
- Click on the **Selection** tool. 
- Click on the first element you want aligned.
- To select more than one element
 - Hold down the **Shift** key and click on another element.
 - Continue to hold down the **Shift** key and click to select the rest of the elements.

CONTROL PALETTE

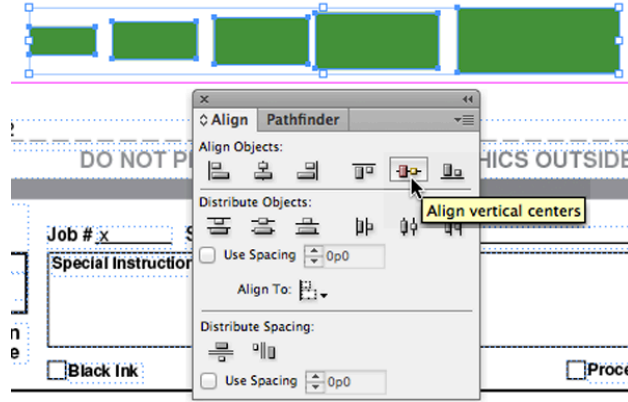
- Use the **Align** options on the **Control** palette.
- With the elements selected, select one or more of the the **Vertical** or **Horizontal** alignment options
- First row options:
 - Align left edge, Align horizontal centers, Align right edges, Align to selection
- Second row options:
 - Align top edges, Align vertical centers, Align bottom edges
- **Distribute** options are to the right of the Align options
- Select a **Vertical** or **Horizontal** distribution option
- First row options:
 - Distribute top edges, Distribute vertical centers, Distribute bottom edges
- Second row options:
 - Distribute left edges, Distribute horizontal centers, Distribute right edges
- **Save** the file.



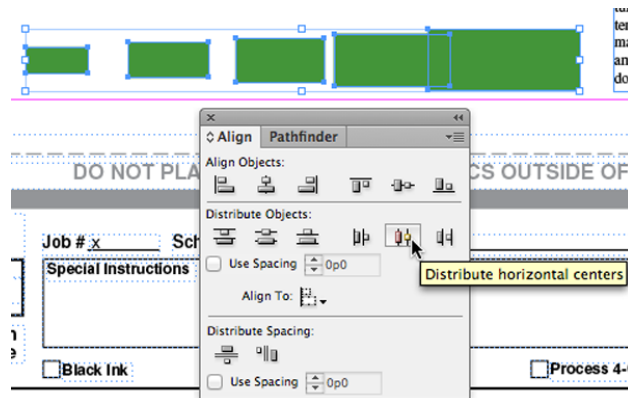
ALIGN PANEL



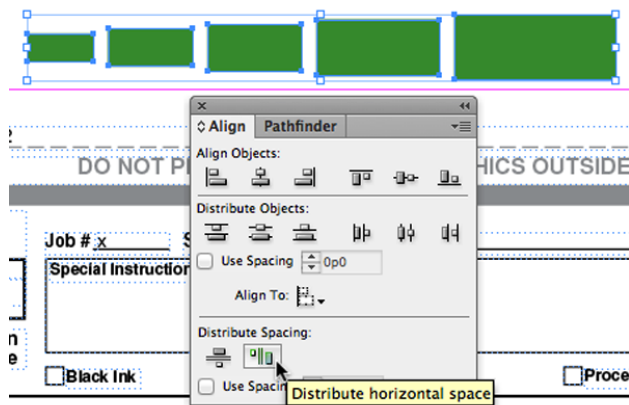
- Select **Window > Object & Layout > Align** to open the **Align** panel.
- With the elements selected, click on one or more of the options.
- In the **Align** palette, click one of the **Vertical** or **Horizontal** alignment options in the **Align Objects** section.



- Select a **Vertical** or **Horizontal** distribution option in the **Distribute Objects** section.

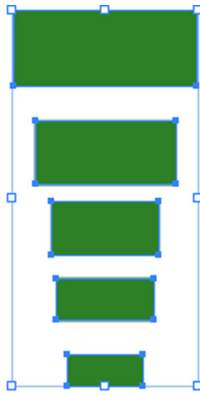


- If elements overlap, click **Distribute Horizontal Space** to evenly space the elements.
- **Save** the file.

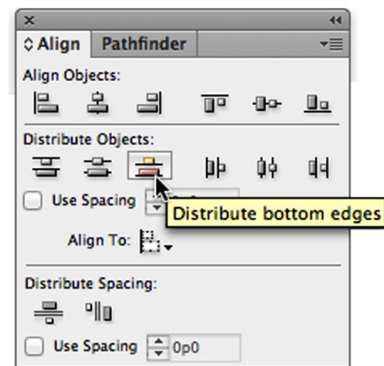
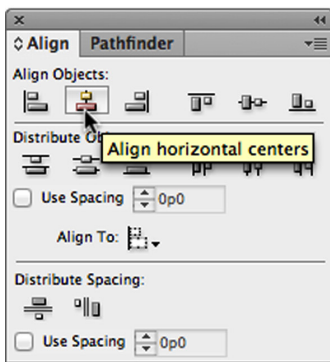
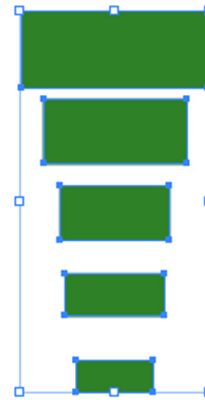




Vertical examples: Align Horizontal Centers



Distribute Bottom Edges



- There is also an option for **Distribute Spacing**.
 - Choose **Distribute Vertical Space** or **Distribute Horizontal Space**.
 - Select **Use Spacing** to specify the space amount.
- **Save the file.**
