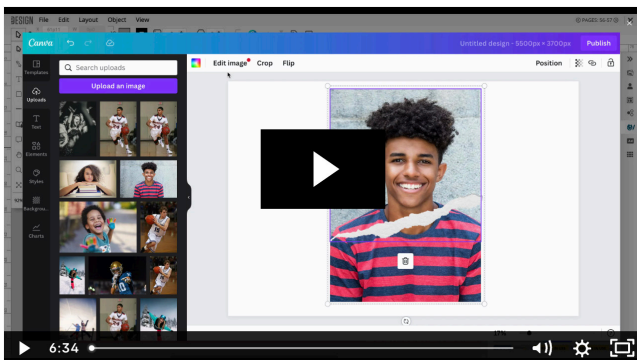
THE LOOK



THE STEPS

1. Open a **horizontal canvas** in Canva from eDesign.
*Tip: If you're working on the page, you can do this from the blue 'C' in the control panel.
If you're in the Art Library, go to Import > Create in Canva.*
2. Click on **"Elements"** in Canva.
3. Click on the option for **"Frame"** at the top of the panel. Any shape with the drawing of the rolling hills and blue sky is a frame you can use.
4. Find the frame you'd like to use and click on it so that it appears on your canvas.
5. Search for **"folded paper frame"** to play with those options.
6. Search for **"gradient frame"** to play with those options.
7. Click on the **"Uploads"** section and find the image you want to use.
If there isn't one there, you can click "Upload Image" to bring one in. Click and drag the photo you want to use right into the frame.
8. When you're done, click **"Publish"** to send this framed image back to your Art Library in eDesign.
