We're coming up on the finish line, spring-delivery books. (Hey summer/fall deliveries, we see you too. Keep it up!) If you're feeling a bit worried about covering all those last-minute events, why not consider a quick-turn supplement?

Adding supplements to your book can take the heat off your staff and open up new avenues for coverage. They are ordered separately from the yearbook and have a shorter turnaround time, so you can hit your final deadline but keep going with covering important school events. And if you're needing one last assignment, this is a great way to gauge your students' skills.

## LET'S CHAT: Three ways to use supplements

- 1. All the coverage: With its two- to three-week turnaround, you have a bit more time to include coverage you maybe can't fit into your main book — like spring sports, prom and graduation. Or, if you're feeling like student coverage is low, you can add all the talking heads and mods you need to include as many students as possible.
- 2. Senior celebration: Create a 16-page supplement specifically for seniors. This is a great place for senior quotes and superlatives, for class trip pics and the selfies that capture the best friendships. Highlight all of those end-of-year activities that bond the senior class.
- **3. Extra ads:** Consider offering an exclusive sponsorship to a local business to cover the cost of the supplement. Or, sell a bunch of lower-cost ads to clubs and organizations. In any case, make sure you have a solid plan for either covering costs or making this a fundraiser for your program.
