# YEARBOOK LADDER

The **ladder** is a page-by-page listing of the yearbook's contents. The number of pages to include in the book is based on financial considerations and the number of students at the school. Once you determine the number of pages in the book, you must choose the content for each page.

**Determine what goes where:** There's no right or wrong way to organize your book. You may put things in the same order as previous years, or you may decide to change things up a bit. Below are some samples of what order schools put their topics in. Be sure to include all the essential topics and any optional ones you choose.

Use the ladder found in your kit to write down where you plan to place content. We recommend using a pencil or sticky notes if you need to move things around. You can find a digital version at **ybk.link/kit-materials**. Once you've penciled in your pages, head to eDesign to assign topics on your ladder. This will help you stay organized while you complete pages.
